

## Kutubuddin appointed honorary consul of Timor-Leste

Kutubuddin Ahmed, chairman of Sheltech Group, Envoy Legacy and Envoy Textiles Ltd, has been appointed as the honorary consul of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste in Bangladesh, said a letter signed by Benedito dos Santos Freitas, the minister of foreign affairs and cooperation of Timor-Leste.

Kutubuddin was awarded the Title of Knight Officer of the Spanish Royal Order of Merit by the King of Spain in 2020.

He is the former president of Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA), Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MCCI).

He was also awarded with the Business Person of the Year 2016 by DHL and The Daily Star.

Over one year, the project operated in six districts and facilitated dialogues between 64 government representatives and Dalits with marginalised communities regarding RTI. Training sessions were conducted for 146 teachers on gender and RTI, while 130 government officials and 23 elected women representatives also received training. 344 courtyard meetings were organised, engaging more than 4,000 women participants. In addition, 1,369 RTI applications were filed, with 1,205 (88 percent) of those submitted by women.

Alena Tansey, director of the Democracy, Human Rights, and Governance Office at USAID Bangladesh, commended these efforts.

She emphasised that women make up half of Bangladesh's population, and their active participation is essential for achieving inclusive development.

The people of

Bangladesh are naturally curious and regularly share information; this exchange of knowledge should be institutionalised to further empower women, she said.

Mohammed Humayun Kabir, additional secretary of the Cabinet Division, emphasised that to address and eliminate inequality, RTI must be effectively implemented.

"In today's world, information is power; therefore, to empower women in Bangladesh, we must ensure their access to information."

SM Kamrul Islam, director of the Information Commission Bangladesh, said people are the true owners of this country. Therefore, whenever they seek information, those in public service must disclose it.

Four beneficiaries from the Rajshahi, Satkhira, Khagrachari, and Sylhet regions shared their transformative stories in the event.

The resigning chairman and commissioners may continue their duties until a new commission assumes office if they wish. However, none of the three who resigned appeared at the ACC headquarters yesterday.

According to meeting sources, the secretary urged everyone to continue fulfilling their

responsibilities from their resignations.

Akhtar Hossain, director general (prevention) of ACC, told The Daily Star, "The ACC's ongoing investigations and probes will proceed as usual."

When asked about the timeline for forming a new commission or a search committee to oversee this process, he said, "I have no information regarding this."

The project authorities of primary education, they said.

"We hope the complexities will be over soon," RHD Chief Engineer Syed Moinul Hasan told The Daily Star after the meeting.

In February 2021, Ecneq approved the Tk 16,918.59 crore project to turn the Dhaka Sylhet Highway into a four-lane highway with service lanes on both sides.

The project authorities have hired contractors for the job but are facing problems as they have yet to acquire most of the land, project officials said.

At least 22 primary schools will be affected by the expansion works. Of them, five schools will be affected slightly, meaning boundary wall or playground will be affected but not the educational activities, shows a project document. Classrooms of 17 other schools will be affected, and thus the school buildings need to be relocated, it says.

"We have talked with the upazila and division primary education officers for over a year but to no avail," said a project official.

It was decided to hold another meeting with the officials of primary

and mass education ministry and directorate of primary education, as no representatives from them were present at yesterday's meeting. The project also faced issues over acquiring land from Power Grid Company Ltd in Narsingdi and Sreehatto Economic Zone. All sides agreed to solve the problem.

Another project that is facing land-related problems is SASEC-2 Road Connectivity Project, under which a 190km road from Tangail's Elenga to Rangpur will be turned to a four-lane highway with service roads.

The project has problems over acquiring land from Bangladesh Institute of Research and Training on Applied Nutrition in Rangpur's Pirganj upazila.

Four other projects, which were facing similar problems, are Itakhola-Mathkola-Kadiati road expansion project; Nayapara-Araihazar-Narsingdi-Raypura road expansion project; Kumargao-Badhaghat-Bimanbandar road expansion project; and Ashuganj River Port-Sarail-Dharkhar-Akhaura Land Port road expansion project.

## 5 protesters hurt as police charge

Mentionable, the interim government has already raised the age limit to 32 years.

Yesterday, during a rally held at Shahbagh Public Library, protesters criticised the interim government, alleging that decisions are being made with undue priority given to two figures - Hasnat Abdullah, convener of the Anti-Discrimination Students Movement, and Sarjis Alam, general secretary of the July Martyr Memorial Foundation.

"Are Sarjis and Hasnat the only ones that matter in this country?" questioned Ahmed Tanjid, an organiser of the protest. "It seems whatever they desire, the interim government implements. If that's true, there's no need to follow the constitution," he said.

Saifur Rahman, a former Dhaka University student, said, "A committee was formed to find whether

our demands have logical grounds. The committee recommended increasing the age limit to 35 years."

"The civil society and almost all political parties have a positive stance regarding our demands. However, the interim government decided to listen to Hasnat and Sarjis and increase the limit by two years only. We urge the government to take action to increase the age limit to 35," he added.

Sharif, a senior lawyer of the Supreme Court, was placing arguments before the HC bench of Justice Farah Mahbub and Justice Debasish Roy Chowdhury during a hearing on the rule that questioned the constitutionality of the 15th amendment.

The bench later fixed November 6 for resuming the hearing.

Earlier in the day, Sharif told the HC that the 13th amendment

"The problem started a few years ago with an unwise decision to take seven Dhaka colleges out of National University and incorporate them into Dhaka University. As a result, problems rose on both sides - Dhaka University and the seven colleges. For this, students of those colleges had to suffer various difficulties and discriminations. The issues are complex and require at least some time to consider what a fair solution can be," he said in the statement.

"As a teacher, I have

every sympathy for the fair demands of students. But it must be remembered that there is no precedent for taking an immediate decision to form a new university through student blockades, agitations, and ultimatums," he added.

The students, however, said the committee does not include educationists or student representation. "We will only leave the streets once we have a separate commission," Nayim said.

Ariff said the tenure for union parishad was initially set at three years but later extended to five. However, there has been no clear evidence of any benefit from this extension, nor has there been any evaluation.

"With a three-year tenure, five rounds of elected representatives could serve over 15 years, allowing a larger number of public representatives to contribute to these institutions," he explained.

Responding to a question on the removal of union parishad chairpersons and members, Ariff clarified that no final decisions have been made.

He said administrators have already been appointed from among government officials to ensure uninterrupted services in city corporations and municipalities.

Full-term administrators will soon be appointed in these areas to secure consistent public services, he added.
