

Habiba Huq passes away

Habiba Huq passed away at her Dhaka residence on Sunday.
Born on July 11, 1931, Habiba, nominated by the Muslim League, participated in the 1954 general election. She lost the contest by some votes to Razia Banu, granddaughter of Sher-e-Bangla AK Fazlul Huq.
Huq published two volumes of poetry in Bangla. She was also known for her social works.
She is survived by her children Sharmin Huq, Yasmin Huq, Nazmeen Huq, Farzeen Huq, and Ejaz Huq. She also left behind seven grandchildren.
Her namaz-e-janaza will be held after Jhr prayers at Masjid-Ut-Taqwa in Dhanmondi on November 5.

Hilsa surge right

Prices have reportedly decreased by Tk 100-300 per kilogramme since the ban was lifted. Notably, larger hilsa remain rare, and most of the available fish do not contain eggs.
Abdur Rahim, a trader at Mahipur fish landing centre in Patuakhali, said hilsa availability in local rivers remains low, with only about 200 maunds observed.
Many fishermen have headed out to the sea, hoping for a better catch.
Barishal District Fisheries Officer Bimal Chandra Das confirmed a surge in hilsa on the market but noted that the fish are relatively small.
Fishermen are known to start fishing just before the ban ends, he added. He said most of these fish were likely caught legally.
Divisional Fisheries Officer Nripindranath

Biswas said traders sometimes preserve fish independently and sell them post-ban.
He said they did not find any fish in the cold storage. "If any trader stored fish privately, we cannot do much about that," he added.
During the 22-day ban, the authorities conducted 3,394 operations and 1,100 mobile court sessions across the region. These efforts led to 681 individuals being fined and over 18 tonnes of illegally caught hilsa being seized, resulting in a total of Tk 32.97 lakh in fines, he said.

The only way to ensure access for all.
"We are handing over our resources to multinational companies with the aid of bureaucrats... This system must be dismantled. When discussing energy, we must also consider trees and the environment," he added.
Prof M Shamsul Alam, energy adviser to the Consumers Association of Bangladesh, praised the government's decision of not invoking the indemnity provision of the Bangladesh Quick Enhancement of Electricity and Energy Supply Act 2010 but urged them to fully repeal the act.
"We will take the matter to court if it isn't scrapped. Additionally, the ministry must transfer fuel price-setting authority to the Bangladesh Energy Regulatory Commission. The BEREC should hold public hearings for accountability before determining fuel and electricity prices," he said.
He also called for investigations into two development funds for the gas and power sectors, alleging misappropriation of public funds under the previous regime.
The seminar was chaired by REB Chairman Major General S M Zia-Ul-Azim.

government to hold the national election quickly.
"People will decide who should be rejected and who should be accepted through the election. So, any imprudent decision will not bring welfare or peace to the country," he stated.
The Swadhinata Forum, a pro-BNP platform, commemorated National Revolution and Solidarity Day on November 7.
Gayeshwar, a member of the BNP Standing Committee, said the term "reform" became stigmatised during the 1/11 political changeover due to ulterior motives.
He said while there is widespread support for necessary state reforms, attempts to consolidate power by banning a political party or promoting depoliticisation will not serve the nation's interests.
"Those who deserve banning have, in effect, banned themselves and departed from the country; now there is no one to raise their banner or slogans," he asserted.
The BNP leader said political parties should not engage in retribution and discouraging attendance at events featuring controversial figures. Officials are advised to be vigilant for controversial images or symbols on invitation materials, crests, certificates, banners, PowerPoint slides, trophies, and logos.

pilot phase has already shown promising results in terms of usability and data quality.
Additional Police Commissioner (Traffic) Khondoker Nazmul Hasan said, "With this app, we can now analyse the primary causes of accidents and identify the locations where they occur most frequently. Once fully operational, we intend to use these insights to introduce preventive measures, which will transform our approach to road safety," added.
The DMP's initiative has encountered some challenges, including personnel transfers and political changes, which briefly slowed the project's momentum.
However, Nazmul Hasan said additional training would soon be provided to newly appointed officers to ensure that all traffic personnel are equipped to use the app effectively.
"The more accurate data we gather, the better we can tailor our responses. This

initiative is expected to play a key role in reducing accidents and enhancing road safety in Dhaka," he added.
Dr Kazi Md Shifun Newaz of BUET's Accident Research Institute said police officers already have access to an Accident Reporting Form for documenting accidents but have not always used it systematically.
"With the new DARC app, if traffic officials take responsibility for filling in required fields accurately, and if the data is verified properly, it could create a highly valuable database," said Dr Newaz.
He commended DARC as a strong first step in Dhaka but argued for the need to expand the system nationwide.
"While it's a positive start as a pilot in the capital, establishing a unified national platform would be essential to significantly reduce traffic accidents across the country," he added.

According to BR, the accused gateman has been working at this spot for six years.

Students demand

The protesters highlighted a recruitment freeze for medical technologists, which has persisted for over 14 years.
Currently, only 4,106 of the 5,975 government-sanctioned medical technologist positions are filled. The students cited World Health Organization (WHO) standards that recommend a ratio of three nurses and five medical technologists per doctor.
Many technologists have now exceeded the age limit for government jobs due to recruitment delays, the

protesters said, pointing to prolonged discrimination and administrative issues as obstacles.
Sohel Howladar, joint secretary of the platform, said DGHS officials, including the director general, have assured the protesters that their demands will be addressed.
"We were assured that steps would be taken to meet our demands, so we cleared the road. However, if the demands remain unmet, we will announce further actions, including a long march," Sohel told The Daily Star.

The ministry's instructions emphasise verifying the history of the inviting organisation or institution and discouraging attendance at events featuring controversial figures. Officials are advised to be vigilant for controversial images or symbols on invitation materials, crests, certificates, banners, PowerPoint slides, trophies, and logos.

causing discomfort. The DC detained five individuals involved in the programme, releasing them eight hours later after a written undertaking.
The directive also instructs government employees to ensure that national days cancelled by the current government are not commemorated. Any books, souvenirs, or memorabilia related to these cancelled days or individuals must be removed from offices. Officials are encouraged to prepare written statements for events and avoid slogans outside of the authorised statements. Additionally, steps should be taken to prevent employees from being misled by rumours.
A senior secretary, speaking anonymously to The Daily Star, said while the directive is manageable for secretaries, it presents challenges for field administrators like upazila nirbahi officers and divisional commissioners, who are frequently involved in local events.
A DC from the northern region added that the new directive complicates their duties, requiring additional background checks before attending functions.
The Ministry of Public Administration has instructed all secretaries to formally inform their respective offices to ensure all government employees are aware of these new guidelines.
