## Railway cancels lease of 24 privately-run trains

Under the arrangement, a private company, through competitive bidding, will earn the job of selling train tickets as fixed by BR and checking those on board.

The company will give a fixed amount to BR vearly and take the rest of the money they will earn the contract for violations from selling tickets to passengers.


