DUJ faction concerned over revoking accreditation of journos

A faction of Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) vesterday expressed concern over government's decision of revoking accreditation cards of over 200 journalists.

It said the move is a threat to independent journalism.

In a statement, DUJ President Sohel Haider Chowdhury and General Secretary Akhtar Hossain protested the government's move and requested it to reconsider the decision.

information The ministry has so far cancelled the press accreditation of 167 journalists including newspaper reporters, editors, and television chief executive officers.

The DUJ requested the government to create environment independent journalism aiming to build a democratic, liberal and exploitation-free state.

All Dhaka buses to run under 'Nagar Paribahan'

All passenger buses in the capital are scheduled to operate under Dhaka Nagar Paribahan, according to new decision by Bus Route Rationalization Committee (BRCC) yesterday.

However, the ownership of the buses will remain with the respective companies.

Dhaka south city administrator and committee Chairman Nazrul Islam briefed the media after BRCC made the decision in its 29th meeting at Dhaka South City Corporation headquarters.

Applications from the bus companies for operating bus services under Nagar Paribahan will be accepted until November 30, he said.

The decision to restart Dhaka Nagar Paribahan, was announced by BRRC, aiming to ease traffic congestion in Dhaka and provide passengers with comfortable transport

Nazrul said the problems with Dhaka's transport system seems endless. Extensive discussions have been held with law enforcement agencies, bus owners' association, and transport workers' union to this end.

Using the opportunity created by the student and public uprising for a new Bangladesh, it will be possible to restore order on the streets, he said.

KALAPARA-DHANKHALI ROAD

Illegal canal excavation triggers road collapse

Kalapara-Dhankhali road in Patuakhali's Kalapara upazila has begun collapsing in several areas, with cracks forming in many sections.

The poor condition of the road is due to illegal soil excavation from the nearby Rajpara canal, which flows parallel to the road. This has put locals at risk, forcing them to navigate the damaged road with caution.

According to the upazila administration, the total estimated damage to the road is around Tk 50

Last year, a local group illegally excavated soil from the Rajpara canal to sell to a brick kiln, significantly deepening the canal with the use of heavy machinery.





advantage of the deepened canal to cultivate fish. For several days, Ferdaus has been draining the canal to harvest his fish stock, which Recently, two influential fish sparked a dispute between him and for daily commuting by teachers,

As the water levels in the canal dropped, the road started cracking, and despite warnings from locals to stop, Ferdaus continued to drain the canal, worsening the road's

By last week, the situation had escalated, with more sections of the road in danger, causing fear among the local residents.

Mahbub Mia, a local resident, reported that a significant portion of the road fell into the canal early Friday morning, while additional cracks had appeared.

"Any time, this road could completely collapse," he said. "We, and many other families living along the canal, are worried about the risks."

PUBLIC ADMIN ACADEMY Allocation of 700-acre forest land cancelled

The government has cancelled a 700-acre land allocation to Ministry of Public Administration for establishing Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Academy of Public Administration in Cox's Bazar.

This decision, prompted by Environment Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan, aims to protect forest land.

The area, located in Jhilanja Mouza, includes 400 acres of hill and 300 acres of stream land, and is designated as protected forest since 1935 under the Forest Act, 1927.

A letter issued by the Ministry of Land on November 10 signed by Deputy Secretary Aminur Rahman, asked the deputy commissioner of Cox's Bazar to take necessary actions to protect the area.

123 crude bomblike objects found in 10 bags

A total of 123 crude bomb-like objects in 10 bags were found in roadside bushes in Damudya upazila of Shariatpur yesterday morning.

Hafizur Rahman Milon, officer-in-charge of Damudya Police Station, said locals first noticed the bags in the bushes in Akalbarish area and informed police. "The objects appear to be crude bombs wrapped in insulation tape," said Milon.

Besides police and army personnel, a bomb disposal team from Dhaka inspected the spot and destroyed the objects, said Nazrul Islam, superintendent of Shariatpur district police.

They were arrested on Sunday after Muntaha's body was discovered in a pond near her home. She had been missing since November 3, and her

remains were found buried in the pond, prompting an investigation and subsequent arrests.

A three-member bench of the Appellate Division headed by Justice Md Ashfaqul Islam fixed today for passing the order.


4 killed in train accident
