66 dead as city convulsed with violence

Protesters stormed the Gono Bhaban, PMO, and parliament building.

"Braving the rain, many with their family members started flocking to the Central Shaheed Minar since morning — first in their hundreds and then in their thousands. They carried the national flag, banners, and placards from across the city, including Rampura, Badda, Dhanmondi, Science Laboratory, and Mirpur areas. As the rally began, the crowd poured over onto the Doyel Chatter in the east, Jagannath Hall in the west, Dhaka Medical College Hospital gate area in the south, and Shibbari intersection in the north. The areas reverberated with anti-government slogans such as "Dofa Ek, Dabi Ek, Sheikh Hasinar Podotyag [One point, one demand, the resignation of Sheikh Hasina]".
