Mong: regional political parties that did not emerge from genuine aspirations of the people but were formed by vested quarters for particular objectives should not exist once the peace accord is fully implemented.

When the accord was signed, all hill communities unitedly supported it. Not only the hill people but also progressive and democraticminded individuals across the country backed its full implementation. Therefore, we are indeed united. The question of why the hill communities cannot remain united is irrelevant in this context.

TDS: The government is promising reforms in different areas. However, the hill people have expressed concerns that their representation was not ensured in the reform commissions. How do the hill communities

**KSMong:** The indigenous communities of CHT have consistently advocated for an inclusive Bangladesh. We have neither talked about separatism nor demanded it. After the uprising, the government pledged reforms and promised a "new Bangladesh." This is seen as a positive step by the hill people.

TDS: It has been nearly 27 years since the peace accord was signed, yet the hill core issues -- rehabilitation of repatriated and internally displaced indigenous people, demilitarisation, activation of regional and district councils, and operationalisation of the land commission -- remain

unaddressed. Why? **KS Mong:** Beyond the you mentioned, issues several other critical matters remain unresolved. For example, the transfer of administration and law enforcement to the district councils and the regional council, as stipulated in the accord, has not been implemented.

The three district councils in the CHT were established to ensure self-governance and preserve the indigenous population's characteristics and identity. However, the necessary amendments to relative laws to enhance their authority have not been made.

Additionally, a local police force has not been established. Police from outside the CHT cannot fully understand the region's distinctiveness. A set of regulations defining the roles and responsibilities of all stakeholders needs to be finalised to operationalise the land commission. But this has yet to happen.

Elections for the three district councils and the regional council require a voter list comprising permanent residents of CHT. Without this, the elections cannot take place.

The TDS: Land Commission was formed in 2001 in line with the accord, vet it hasn't resolved a single land-related dispute.

KS Mong: A regulation

population claims that its outlining its operational framework must formulated to make the commission effective. This has not been done.

> After the current government came to power, we met with advisers for law, land, and CHT affairs. Both the law and CHT advisers agreed that the CHT Affairs ministry should take the initiative to draft these regulations. This is a positive step.

**TDS:** What immediate steps should the interim government take to fully implement the accord?

**KS Mong:** Apart from the above-mentioned issues, the Land Commission and the CHTAccord Implementation and Monitoring Committee must be restructured. Additionally, the advisory committee under the Ministry of CHT Affairs should be reconstituted.

Furthermore, government must swift action to rebuild trust among the hill people.


