VICTORY DAY CELEBRATIONS **12 AL leaders** arrested over sabotage plot

Police have arrested 12 leaders and activists of the Awami League on charges of planning to carry out sabotage activities during the Victory Day celebrations in Gazipur.

A Gazipur court sent them to jail yesterday after Solaiman Molla, president of BNP's Kapasia Durgapur union, filed a case against them with Kapasia Police Station on Friday night, said Kamal Hossain, officer-in-charge of Kapasia Police Station. In the case, the plaintiff named 59 individuals.

Quoting locals, the OC said the suspects were planning to carry out sabotage activities in the isolated Dhadhar Char area around 2:30pm on Friday. They were detained by local residents and later handed over to police.

The arrested individuals include Afzal Hossain alias Rinkon, 30, of Ghagtia Union, former organising secretary of the Upazila Chhatra League; Maruf, 25, from the same village and vice-president of Ward-4 Jubo League; Abul Kalam Azad, 45, a member of Ward-6 Awami League; and Ilias Ahmed, 45, from Khirati village and social welfare secretary of Ghagtia Union Awami League.

15kg of earthworms every month at home, which she sells profitably. "I also grow vegetables in

my yard year-round using some of the vermicompost I produce," she added.

Mobarak Hossain, 60, from Panchagram village in Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila, said, "I produce vermicompost at home, keep a portion for my own vegetable cultivation, and sell the rest to local fertiliser dealers, who then sell it to other farmers."

When contacted, Al Mamun, Abdullah director deputy of the DAE in Kurigram, emphasised that the use of vermicompost is essential for producing toxin-free vegetables and maintaining soil fertility.

"We have been encouraging farmers to use vermicompost for cultivation. In recent years, its use has increased significantly, benefiting many marginal farmers in the region," he added.

to meteorological classifications, temperatures between 8 and 10 degrees Celsius signify a mild cold wave, 6 to 8 degrees Celsius a moderate one, and below 6 degrees Celsius a severe cold wave.

The cold has led to a surge in cold-related illnesses.

Rakibul Alam, Dr resident medical officer at the 250-bed Thakurgaon Modern Hospital, confirmed an increased influx of patients suffering from respiratory and other cold-induced ailments.

District administrations Thakurgaon and Panchagarh have initiated warm clothing distribution among the cold-affected, but the demand far outweighs the supply.
