Vermicompost is primarily used in fruit and vegetable farming, so its production and demand have grown significantly," said Md Ashikur Rahman, a deputy assistant agriculture officer at the DAE, Pabna.

Mita Sarkar, Ishwardi upazila agriculture officer, said, "Earthworms process cow dung into vermicompost over time. While repetitive crop cultivation and excessive use of chemical fertilisers reduce soil fertility, vermicompost helps restore fertility and enhances crop yields at a lower cost. It's suitable for almost all types of crops, so we're encouraging farmers to use it more."

BAGERHAT'S KACHUA UPAZILA
Waterlogging threatens Boro cultivation

Thousands of farmers in Kachua upazila, Bagerhat, are facing a critical situation as waterlogging has rendered over 1,000 bighas of land unsuitable for Boro cultivation. Villages such as Sangdia, Kolmibunia, and Pingoria are struggling with stagnant water that refuses to recede.

Hossain Paik, a 25-year-old farmer from Kolmibunia village, said, "I have two fish enclosures spread over five bighas of land. The waterlogging has made it impossible for me to plant Boro paddy this season. If the water doesn't recede soon, there won't be any time left to cultivate."

The problem is exacerbated by the malfunctioning of the Arijkhali sluice gate, which, according to locals, allows water to enter but not drain out.

Rafiqul Paik, a 28-year-old farmer from the same village, said, "I can't cultivate on my two bighas of land because the water won't drain. I have



no solution in sight," he said.

In Shrirampur village, Shishir Das, 45, has been trying to pump water out of his eight bighas of land, but his efforts have been fruitless. "Even after removing water multiple times, it keeps coming back. I am helpless as the planting season slips away," he said.

The situation has left the farming community uncertain and financially strained, as Boro is

one of the region's most important crops. The prolonged waterlogging not only threatens these farmers' livelihoods but also raises concerns about food security in the area.

When contacted, Abu Rayhan Md Al-Biruni, executive engineer of the Water Development Board in Bagerhat, said steps are being taken to address the issue.

He, however, did not specify a timeline for resolving the problem.

73 noted citizens slate attack

government caretaker advisers Sultana Kamal and Rasheda K Chowdhury; Sammilito Samajik Andolan Presidium Member Ramendu Majumder; Liberation War Museum Trustee Sarwar Ali; Sammilito Samajik Andolan President Professor Anwar Hossain; Bangladesh Hindu Buddha Unity Council General Secretary Rana Dasgupta; Bangladesh Mahila Parishad President Faozia Moslem; Platform Against Communalism and Militancy Member Secretary Nur Mohammad Talukder; Bangladesh Krishak Samiti President SMA Sabur; and rights activist Khushi Kabir.

In another statement, 46 eminent citizens demanded punishment for the accused. It condemned the failure of law enforcers to protect peaceful protesters, despite the attackers signaling their violent plans on social

media the day before. The signatories made six demands: an urgent, impartial high-level investigation into the attacks; the arrest and punishment of the perpetrators; ensuring medical care for the injured; including chapters on indigenous history in textbooks; an apology and reinstatement of the "Adivasi" graffiti by NCTB; and an explanation for law enforcements' silence.

The signatories include Meghna Guhathakurta, executive director of Research Initiatives, Bangladesh; photographer and writer Shahidul Alam; acting CEO of BELA Taslima Islam; and senior Supreme Court lawyer ZI Khan Panna.

Demanding justice over Wednesday's attack, protest programmes were organised in various districts, including Rangamati, Khagrachhari, Bandarban, Moulvibazar,

and Mymensingh yesterday. Meanwhile, 500 citizens including teachers, students, indigenous and political activists yesterday demanded reinstatement of the graffiti featuring the word "Adivasi" on the Class IX-X textbooks.

The graffiti was removed after an organisation called "Students for Sovereignty" protested against it.

Such action by the NCTB not only disregards the identity and rights of indigenous people but also directly contradicts the anti-discrimination spirit of the July uprising, they said. The citizens said indigenous culture and history should be accurately represented in the textbooks.

Furthermore, the refusal to recognise them as "indigenous" in the constitution, labelling them instead as "tribal" or "small ethnic groups," has demeaned their status and denied their rights, they said. They called upon all to unite against such hateful actions.

The signatories include Dhaka University teachers Gitiara Nasreen, Mohammad Tanzimuddin Khan, Kamal Chowdhury, Samina Luthfa and Rushad Faridi, Supreme Court lawyer Jyotirmoy Barua, Adviser to the Chakma Circle Rani Yen Yen, rights activist Rayhan Rhyne, pro-vice-chancellor of Bangladesh Open University Sayeed Ferdous.

International University (over 59pc), National Institute of Preventive and Social Medicine (NIPSOM) (over 58pc), BRAC University (James P Grant School of Public Health) (over 55pc), North South University (over 40pc), and other institutions (over 69pc).

The survey, however, did not include an equal number of participants from all institutions.

Addressing the event, Professor Mohammad Zahurul Islam of NSU emphasised that public health graduates that public health institutions face fewer challenges due to better communication skills and curriculum diversity.

Dr Ataur Rahman, director of Center for Professional Skill Development and a contributor to the report, said hiring external faculty and high dropout rates among public health students contribute to these challenges.

Professor Rounaq Jahan, convener of BHW Advisory Council and distinguished fellow at Center for Policy Dialogue (CPD), suggested prioritising reforms in public health education, and advocated for collaboration between public and private institutions, maintaining curriculum standards, and integrating public health into governance frameworks.

Speaking as chief guest, Md Sarwar Bari, secretary to the Medical Education and Family Welfare Division, acknowledged significant progress achieved in public health education recently, and stressed that it should not remain theoretical, and its benefits must be extended to the community level.

Ahmad Mushtaque Raza Chowdhury, convener of BHW, chaired the event. Miranda Beckman, health advisor at Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA), spoke, among others.

Act by appointing a few permanent prosecutors initially, and gradually replacing contract-based lawyers with permanent prosecutors over 5-10 years.

It also asked to automate the ACC's processes, including case management, investigations, secret inquiries, and prosecution through end-to-end automation. It also suggested expanding the Digital Forensic Lab's manpower and capacity and placing it directly under the chairman's supervision.

The commission also proposed setting up an ACC training academy to enhance its financial, administrative, and technical capabilities and to ensure mandatory and regular staff training.

To prevent internal corruption, the commission has advised forming a high-powered task force, with support from government and intelligence agencies, to identify and expel corrupt ACC officials and refer them for criminal prosecution.

ACC spokesperson and Director-General Md Akhtar Hossain declined to make any comments on the report. Dr Iftekharuzzaman, head of the reform commission, said, "There should be diversity in ACC appointments. ACC should recruit from professions directly related to its work

instead of prioritising bureaucrats."

"We (the commission) want the ACC to be independent and effective, but its independence is not limitless. The ACC must be accountable, with recognition for successes and accountability for failures," he added.

The hospital authorities also said the claim of a "wrong surgery" by the patient's family was "extremely unfortunate" and the actual events had been "grossly distorted".

When asked about the matter, Irtiza's father Md Mahmud Hasan said, "We don't understand these technical medical terms like whether foreign body removal is considered an operation. My payment receipt clearly states 'operation charge'. That implies it was a surgery, regardless of its scale. If only one eye had an issue, why did the doctor treat the other?"

"Even though the doctor made a mistake, they didn't initially provide us with a discharge letter. When they eventually did, the error wasn't mentioned in it. We cannot accept their explanation. My child was given anesthesia, and permission was taken for surgery. So how can they claim it wasn't surgery?"

Meanwhile, Dr Shahedara Begum was arrested from her residence in the capital's Elephant Road area early yesterday, following a case filed by the child's father with Dhanmondi Police Station. She was later granted bail by the court the same day.
