The OC said among the named accused, three are students and the others are outsiders. No one has been arrested so far, he added.

Jahidul, 24, was a third-year student in the textile engineering department.

According to the case, Jahidul and several others were having snacks near the campus around 3:00pm. While they were laughing and chatting, two female students of another private university and others were standing nearby. Suddenly, three of them approached the victim, claiming Jahidul's group was laughing at the girls.

The confrontation turned into an altercation, which was initially resolved by campus authorities. However, around 4:40pm, Jahidul was stabbed on the left side of his chest. His body was handed over to the family following an autopsy at Dhaka Medical College Hospital, added the case statement.

Speaking to reporters at the morgue, Humayun said, "My cousin was not involved in any fights. We don't understand why he was killed. We want justice."

Jahidul, the eldest of two siblings, was from Bhaluka upazila in Mymensingh. His father, Jasim Uddin, who works in Kuwait, flew back to Bangladesh yesterday after learning of his son's death.

Meanwhile, Jatiyatobadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leaders claimed Jahidul was one of their activists and alleged SAD leaders were involved in the murder.

At a press conference at the BNP's Nayapaltan office, JCD President Rakibul Islam Rakib said Jahidul played a significant role in the July uprising.

"Our initial investigation shows that several leaders of Students Against Discrimination were directly involved in the murder. CCTV footage clearly identifies those who fatally stabbed him," Rakib claimed, reports UNB.

He said a group of criminals, including Primeasia student

Meheraj Islam and SAD leaders Tushar and Miazzi, stabbed Jahidul.

In response, SAD denied the allegations in a Facebook post, saying Chhatra Dal leaders are spreading falsehoods regarding the involvement of SAD leaders.

"We strongly condemn such falsehoods. Tushar and Miazzi had no involvement whatsoever," the post stated, adding that CCTV footage does not show the presence of these two leaders.

"Even after August 5, perpetrators destroyed evidence. No one responsible has been arrested. My brother and I grew up without a father. Those who caused us all this suffering must face trial," she added.

Adiba Islam Hridi was two and a half years old when her father, Parvez Hossain, a Chhatra Dal leader, was picked up by Rab from Shahbagh on December 2, 2013. For the past nine years, Hridi has been protesting in the streets, holding a photo of her missing father.

Now a teenager and eighth-grade student, Hridi said through tears, "I can't bear being without my father anymore. After August 5, we weren't supposed to be standing like this. If there's no one left in Aynagar, then where are our fathers and uncles?"

Imon -- son of Omar Faruk, who disappeared from Chattogram's Patenga in 2014 -- said Rab picked up his father on February 4 that year, and he has been missing ever since.

"Even after eight months in power, the interim government has failed to

trace our loved ones," he said.

Imon demanded the immediate removal and trial of officials accused of involvement in disappearances and killings. "As long as they remain in service, neither we nor our families are safe," he said.

Afroza Islam Ankhi -- sister of BNP leader Sajedul Islam Sumon, who was picked up in December 2013 -- said, "We've been protesting on the streets for 13 years. It's shocking and shameful that even today, we have to stand here to demand justice."

Following the protest, Mayer Dak coordinator Sanjida Islam Tulee submitted a six-point memorandum to Chief Prosecutor Mohammad Tajul Islam of the International Crimes Tribunal.

She warned that failure to act would result in wider protests.

Their demands include public disclosure of the names of officials involved; the removal and prosecution of perpetrators; preservation of evidence from Aynagar; legal action against

those who destroyed it; constitutional reforms to prevent further abuse; and formal recognition of the victims' suffering.

Leaders from several opposition and rights-based organisations, including Nagorik Oikya President Mahmudur Rahman Manna and Gono Odhikar Parishad General Secretary Rashed Khan, joined in solidarity.

Lt Col (Retd) Hasinur Rahman, who was twice detained in Aynagar, also spoke at the event.

The tribunal also extended until July 29 the deadline for completing investigations into a separate case filed over crimes against humanity committed during the Liberation War in 1971 against Syed Titumir and two other accused.

Titumir, currently on bail, was present during the hearing, while the two other accused have since died.


