

Ease political party registration

Biplabi Gonojote urges EC

Biplabi Gonojote, an alliance of seven political parties and organisations, has called for easing the party registration process by allowing registration with just a central office, central committee, and party constitution under the existing election laws.

The alliance has urged the Election Commission (EC) to amend the registration requirements so that a party can be registered easily.

The demand was made while a seven-member delegation of Biplabi Gonojote held a meeting yesterday with the EC, led by Chief Election Commissioner AMM Nasir Uddin, at the Election Bhaban in Dhaka's Agargaon.

Biplabi Gonojote was formed in November last year.

The alliance includes Bangladesh Gonomukti Party, Bangladesh Green Party, Biplobi Gorib Party, Bangladesh Sarbojanin Dal, Bangladesh Peace Forum, Samyabadi Dal of Bangladesh, and the Prayata Neta Smriti Sangshad.

Abdul Monem, coordinator of Biplabi Gonojote and general secretary of Gonomukti Party, said, "We discussed with the commission how the law can be replaced. We demanded that registration be granted with just a central committee, central office, and party constitution."

"The 1/11 government introduced a terrible law in the



Erosion by Teesta, Dharla turns serious

The monsoon has yet to arrive in full swing, but erosion along the Teesta and Dharla rivers has already taken a serious turn in Rangpur region, threatening thousands of families living along the riverbanks.

According to officials of Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB), Teesta's erosion started early, devouring croplands and houses at 130 points in the five districts of Rangpur division –Lalmonirhat, Kurigram, Rangpur, Nilphamari, and Gaibandha.

Meanwhile, 11 erosion-prone spots have emerged along the Dharla riverbanks in Lalmonirhat and Kurigram.

The water levels of the rivers have been rising steadily for a week, intensifying the erosion and devouring homes, cropland, courtyards, and other structures, said affected residents.

"I have lost two bighas of my cropland in just one week, and three bighas are in risk of erosion," said Mahendranath Sen, 60, a farmer from Moghalhat Senpara village under Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila.

Jamal Hossain, 65, from the same village, said, "BWDB officials came, saw the damage, and left. No action has been taken yet, while the river is devouring our village. If the authorities stay silent, where do we go?"

Mobarak Hossain, 65, from Shankardah village in Rangpur's Gangachara upazila, shared similar frustration, "This isn't just our lands we're losing – it's our future. The

erosion has left us helpless. I've lost my home and now live on someone else's land."

"If no permanent solution comes soon, countless families will be left destitute," said Sirajul Islam, 55, of Harinchara village in Lalmonirhat Sadar.

Contacted, Shunil Kumar, executive engineer of BWDB in Lalmonirhat, said erosion is currently occurring at 50-55 points along the Teesta, with preventive measures underway at 13 points. "We're



working with the funds available. Unfortunately, there's no allocation yet for the Dharla side," he added.

Rabiul Islam, BWDB executive engineer in Rangpur, said erosion was reported at 25-26 points along the Teesta, with emergency work going on at eight priority locations.

Mahbubur Rahman, BWDB chief engineer in Rangpur, said a fund of Tk 120 crore is being used in phases to combat Teesta's erosion. "We are inspecting erosion points on both rivers and preparing to take urgent measures," he added.

Seven to die on murder charges

Seven individuals have been sentenced to death in two separate murder cases in Sirajganj and Habiganj, according to reports from our correspondents.

In Sirajganj, six robbers were sentenced to death for abducting and killing a vegetable trader in 2017.

The verdict was announced yesterday by District and Sessions Judge M Ali Ahmed.

The convicts – Khwaza Miah, Enamul, Mojahid, Boshu, Saidul Islam, and Milon Sarkar – were tried in absentia, having absconded after securing bail. Each was also fined Tk 10,000.

According to the case, trader Nazmul Islam was abducted from Gazipur while transporting vegetables from Naogaon to Dhaka. The kidnappers demanded Tk 50,000 in ransom. His body was later recovered from a ditch in Sirajganj.

Police submitted a charge sheet against seven individuals; one died during the trial.

In Habiganj, a court sentenced Shah Alam alias Taher Uddin, 50, to death for killing his sister-in-law, her daughter, and a neighbour in 2016 over a property dispute.

moderated the open discussion, said, "Some within the interim government believe political administrations will not implement these reforms – perhaps that assumption is misplaced. Political governments respond to public demand. The interim government can certainly get the ball rolling. We must seize the low-hanging fruit."

He also highlighted the need for closer engagement with the private sector, describing it as a key stakeholder. "There's a vast disparity in service quality – from excellent to extremely poor – that warrants immediate attention," he said.

On health literacy, Dr Zillur added: "We must focus on the social dynamics of how people access and demand healthcare. This should be brought into the mainstream public discourse."

Presenting the keynote, IHE Professor Dr Syed Abdul Hamid outlined the report's key findings and proposed implementation strategy. "The commission has done its part. It's now time to help the government operationalise these recommendations."

He reiterated the need for a legal framework to establish a Bangladesh Health Commission. "A draft law must be prepared by a dedicated task force and approved by the chief adviser."

IHE Professor Dr Shafiun N. Shimul and Institute Director Dr Sharmeen Mobin Bhuiyan also spoke, stressing institutional reform.

Fear of flash flood looms

Chellakhali river in Sherpur flows above danger level

Due to heavy rainfall over the past four days and an onrush of hilly waters from across the Indian border, the Chellakhali river in Sherpur was flowing 106 centimetres above the danger level yesterday morning, according to the Water Development Board.

Md Akhinuzzaman, executive engineer of the board's Sherpur office, said the river had already reached 128 centimetres above the danger level around 6:00pm yesterday afternoon.

"All rivers in Sherpur, including the Bhugai, are swelling due to continuous rain and the influx of upstream water," he added.

Local residents remain on high alert as fears of a flash flood grow, especially if the water levels continue to rise.

Mohammad Shakhauat Hossain, deputy director of the Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE) in Sherpur, said nearly 94 per cent of Boro paddy has been harvested so far.

"We have advised farmers to harvest their remaining crops as soon as possible to minimise potential losses," he added.



Singer Noble arrested over rape, torture

Police yesterday arrested singer Mainul Ahsan Noble from Dhaka's Demra area on charges of raping a college student after abducting her seven months ago.

A police team arrested him from the Sarulia area around 2:00am after the victim filed a case against him on charges of rape, torture, and pornography, said Mahmudur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Demra Police Station.

Later yesterday noon, Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Zia Uddin ordered to send Noble to jail after Demra police produced him before the court seeking his confinement in jail.

The court rejected a petition seeking Noble's bail.

The victim alleged that Noble and his associates had
