Yunus tells young scouts

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday encouraged the young people engaged in scouting to help open doors for others, discover the world of opportunities, know people better with broader friendship, and contribute to positive changes.

"Scouting has opened a big door of opportunities for you. It is a big opportunity for you to open the door for others," he said while inaugurating the Bangladesh Scouts Cub Carnival at the Chief Adviser's Office.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof Yunus said this is a great opportunity to discover the world and, more importantly, to discover things within the youngsters involved in scouting.

"Otherwise, there is no other opportunity to get to know you. You must

## 'Aggressive nationalism' threatening peace worldwide

Says Prof Serajul Islam Choudhury at event marking his 90th birthday

The present-day world has been witnessing a form of "aggressive nationalism" in various ways, said Prof Serajul Islam Choudhury yesterday.

"The Zionist activities of Israel, the way people are being killed, the way children are being killed in Palestine... all of these represent that aggressive nationalism," he said.

One of the country's foremost public intellectuals, Prof Serajul was addressing the topic "The Liberation War of 1971 and Role of Nationalism" at an event marking his 90th birthday.

"Natun Diganta Paribar", a platform

formed by his colleagues at the magazine Natun Diganta, where Prof Serajul is the editor, organised the discussion at the capital's Bangla Academy.

Delivering a solo lecture, he said war comes in many forms. The war that the masses of Bangladesh fought during 1971 was a "people's war".

Similarly, nationalism also has variations. Nationalism can be aggressive, as well as for resistance, he explained.

He said whereas people of Bangladesh witnessed and experienced the aggressive form of nationalism in 1971 from the Pakistani occupation forces, the nationalism "we upheld during

the Liberation War in 1971 was the nationalism of resistance".

He went on saying foreign powers like the US, China, and Russia, which got involved in Bangladesh's Liberation War, had a "nationalistic" approach.

Besides, India also had its own "nationalistic view" while supporting Bangladesh during the war but it was also humane, as the country gave shelter to hundreds of thousands of Bangladeshi refugees at that time, he added.

Prof Serajul said the present-day world has also been witnessing the killing of people en masse.

"This killing is happening in various

## Freedom of expression vital for democracy

Speakers tell MJF event; 'Swadhinata' project launched

Safeguarding freedom of expression is essential to upholding democratic values in the digital age, said speakers at an event yesterday.

They expressed concern over the growing threat of misinformation and emphasised the importance of digital literacy, inclusive participation, and civic responsibility.

They made the remarks during the launch of the EU-funded "Swadhinata - Freedom of Expression for Digital Democracy (FREEDOM)" project, which was held at a hotel in the capital.

Jointly implemented by Plan International Netherlands, Plan International Bangladesh, and Manusher Jonno Foundation (MJF), the project aims to strengthen freedom of expression, improve information literacy, and promote online safety.

Speakers said the initiative will follow a cascading model to engage young people,

## NAGAR BHABAN REOPENING Services resume on limited scale, protests continue

After remaining shut for 40 consecutive days, the Dhaka South City Corporation headquarters, Nagar Bhaban, reopened yesterday, with the resumption of limited civic services amid ongoing protests.

From early morning yesterday, citizens began arriving in hope of availing essential services. By 9:00am, all gates of Nagar Bhaban were unlocked, except for the DSCC administrator's office and the engineering department, which remained padlocked.

Mansura Khatun, who came from Bashabo, said she had been unable to withdraw a grant for her father's medical treatment during the closure. "Today, I submitted the application again. The
