

## JnU allocates Tk 56cr as housing allowances

Okays Tk 297.82cr budget for FY 2025-26

Jagannath University has approved a Tk 297.82 crore annual budget for 2025-26 fiscal year. The budget was approved yesterday during the university's 102nd (special) Syndicate meeting, presided over by Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Md Rezaul Karim. Of the budget, Tk 56 crore (18.80 percent) has been earmarked for supplementary scholarship category, intended primarily as housing allowances for students, Tk 128.60 crore for salaries and allowances, Tk 84.31 crore for goods and services, Tk 58.21 crore for miscellaneous grants, Tk 8.03 crore for research, Tk 4.92 crore for equipment, Tk 3 crore for transportation, Tk 1.70 crore for ICT, Tk 80 lakh for other capital expenditures, and Tk 25 lakh for primary healthcare. "Tk 56 crore has been allocated for supplementary student grants, and Tk 24.90 crore has been kept for temporary hall construction," said the VC. "Compared to last year, this year's budget has increased by 48 percent," said Treasurer Prof Sabina Sharmin.



## Free health camps for the poor in Moulvibazar, Satkhira

Initiative taken in memory of Latifur Rahman, Faraaz Ayaaz Hossain

Free medical camps have been set up in Moulvibazar and Satkhira in memory of the late Latifur Rahman, chairman of Transcom Group, and his grandson, Faraaz Ayaaz Hossain. Business icon Latifur died in 2020 while Faraaz was brutally killed along with 19 other hostages in a militant attack at a Dhaka café on July 1 in 2016. Eskayef Pharmaceuticals Ltd organised the day-long medical camps in the districts, said Mohammad Rezaul Karim, senior regional sales manager of the pharmaceuticals. In Moulvibazar, around 400 people with health complications got a chance to consult specialised doctors free of cost at the health camp set up at Kaliti Tea garden hospital premises in Kulaura upazila from 10:00am to 4:00pm. Most of the patients are tea workers and medicines



have been provided to them free of cost, said Md Shohidul Islam, senior field manager at the Eskayef Pharmaceuticals Ltd in Kulaura. Mina Pashii, 55, said, "Today, for the first time, I've got the opportunity to consult a qualified doctor without any cost. Not only I was given medical advice but also I received the necessary medicines for free." Sondha Robidas, 44, a tea worker, said, "I've been struggling with breathing problems due to asthma, and it's been getting worse over time. Unfortunately, I couldn't afford to visit a doctor or buy the medicines I needed. But today, I have been able to get medical check up and received inhalers and other medicines for free." In Satkhira, the camp began around 9:30am at the Diabetes and General Hospital located in Karim Super Market in Assasuni upazila and continued till 4:00pm. It treated and provided medicines to around 450 patients.

## 'Santal rebellion day' observed

Members of the Santal community in Gaibandha yesterday observed the historic "Santal rebellion day" in Gobindaganj upazila with various programmes commemorating the uprising and highlighting the ongoing struggles for land rights of indigenous communities. The day's events included paying homage to the martyrs, followed by a procession and rallies. Speakers said indigenous communities remain vulnerable, without possession of their ancestral lands for generations. They demanded immediate return of their land, and urged the government to take effective measures to protect their rights. The Santal rebellion, also known as Santal "Hool", is observed on June 30 every year. It first took place in 1855 against the British misrule and extortion. Santal leaders Sidhu and Kanu, along with many others, were killed in the rebellion.

## Project to combat NCD launched

A project, "Community-Based NCD Management Capacity Strengthening in Mirzapur, Bangladesh (2025-2027)," officially commenced yesterday, said a press release. Funded by KOICA, this three-year initiative brings together GlobalCare and the PMCI with the Kumudini Welfare Trust of Bengal (BD) Ltd and its flagship Kumudini Hospital to combat the rising burden of non-communicable diseases (NCDs) like hypertension and diabetes in Mirzapur. With over 70 percent of deaths in Bangladesh caused by NCDs, the government has developed a robust management system but continues to face challenges, including shortages of medicine and low public awareness. In Mirzapur, only about 10 percent of NCD patients are currently registered under the government system. The project aims to enhance health system capacity, improve community engagement, and advocate for policy change. The launch event was held at BP Pati Hall, Kumudini Women's Medical College, presided over by Syed Zakir Hossain, professor of medicine and line director, NCDC, Dhaka.

## Two sent to jail over rape of 10-year-old

Two individuals were sent to jail yesterday in connection with the rape of a 10-year-old girl in Faridpur. The girl's mother filed a case against Omar Ali, 48, and Md Jewel, 24, with Faridpur Kotwali Police Station. According to the case, the two took the victim to a house and raped her on Sunday. Hearing her screams, locals rushed to the spot and detained the suspects before alerting police. According to the victim's mother, the girl had mental disabilities. Confirming the incident, Faridpur Kotwali Police Station Officer-in-Charge Asaduzzaman said preliminary investigation revealed that Omar raped the girl while Jewel assisted him. The victim was sent to a one-stop crisis centre for medical examination, the OC added.

has asked the director of Sher-E-Bangla Medical College Hospital in Barishal to send a four-member team of medicine experts to Barguna within two days. The team is expected to provide five days of training to enhance the capacity of local healthcare providers in managing dengue patients. In a separate letter, the DGHS directed its Barishal divisional director to arrange two ambulances for Barguna to support patient transportation. A third letter stressed that late admission of dengue patients is exacerbating complications, and urged the deputy commissioner, superintendent of police, and other relevant officials in the district to initiate necessary awareness campaigns.
