

Ex-CEC Nurul Huda denied bail

A Dhaka court yesterday denied bail to former chief election commissioner KM Nurul Huda in a case filed over alleged irregularities and bias during the past national elections.

Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Md Sefatullah passed the order, Obydul Islam, a defence lawyer, told The Daily Star.

Huda was arrested on June 22 after being assaulted by a mob at his Uttara residence and handed over to police. The following day, the court granted a four-day remand.

On June 27, the court put him on another four-day remand.

KM Nurul Huda yesterday told a court that he had been "kept in the dark" about the nighttime voting during the 2018 national election and blamed "overenthusiastic" government officials for the irregularities.

Arrest culprits, ensure justice

Demand protesters

Workers yesterday demonstrated in Gazipur protesting the killing of a ready-made garment worker and demanding exemplary punishment for the perpetrators.

They held a rally in front of the Gazipur Deputy Commissioner's Office at 1:00pm to press home their demands. Hridoy, 19, a mechanic at the factory of Greenland Garments Ltd in Gazipur, was beaten to death on Saturday, said police.

Shafiul Alam, president of Gazipur unit of Bangladesh Garments and Industrial Workers Federation, said, "The owner of Greenland Garments Ltd cannot escape responsibility for Hridoy's murder. We demand arrest of all those involved, within 24 hours, and maximum punishment for them. Hridoy's family must be compensated and the closed factory should be reopened quickly."

Father, son die from electrocution

A man and his son died from electrocution while retting jute in a waterbody in Chandpur Sadar yesterday.

The deceased are Abdur Rob Tapadar, 60, of Kaddipachgaon area and his son Sayem Tapadar, 23.

Shah Alam, a relative, said Rob got electrocuted after coming into contact with a live wire that had fallen into the water. Sayem also got electrocuted as he tried to save him. They were declared dead at Chandpur Sadar Hospital, said OC Bahar Mia.

Six held over 'staged' foreign currency robbery

A group of individuals looted around five lakh Saudi riyals from an employee of a money exchange trader in Dhaka's Tejgaon on Tuesday night.

However, detectives suspect that the robbery was orchestrated by the employee himself while he was on his way to Uttara from the Baitul Mukarram area in a private car to make payments on behalf of a currency trader.

Six people, including the employee, have been detained over the incident and 2.79 lakh riyals have been recovered from their possession, said Detective Branch Joint Commissioner (North) Rabiul Islam Bhuiyan yesterday.

The employee, identified as Tuhin, had initially claimed that a gang of criminals on three motorcycles intercepted the car near Tejgaon Polytechnic

Corruption Commission, they said.

During the same period, over 1,000 journalists reportedly lost their jobs, press accreditation cards of 168 were cancelled, and 101 journalists had their memberships in various press clubs - including Jatiya Press Club - suspended or revoked. "The control of a media house" was also taken over, the alleged.

The statement said although 10 journalists were killed and many others injured during and after the July uprising, the government has not provided support to the victim families.

The signatories said the public also witnessed an event like a "ziafat" organised by a mob in front of a media house - something they described as unprecedented not only in Bangladesh but globally.

As a result of these repressive actions, many journalists and their families are suffering mentally, socially, and economically, and living a deplorable life. The numbers of such affected individuals continuing to rise, claimed the expatriates in the statement.

They believe the repression has played a major role in silencing free speech and damaging the country's image globally.

Despite the widespread repression, including the filing of cases in a wholesale manner, the government has taken no preventive steps, the statement said.

"This made us suspect that the government itself has been involved in the repressive events," they said.

They described the current level of journalist repression and media suppression as unprecedented in Bangladesh's history and

questioned whether such repression exist anywhere in democratic world.

political parties agree on adopting the proportional representation (PR) system for the national election, it is not being implemented simply due to the objection of one party.

Yet, PR is a tested and effective system to prevent autocracy, he added.

He urged the interim government to remain firm and determined in fulfilling its commitments and responsibilities.

Rezaul said if this government arranges an election under pressure while keeping the path open for autocracy, it will be remembered in history as perpetual offenders.

He said the July uprising was not under the banner or leadership of any traditional political party.

It was a student-initiated movement in which the people joined, and at a later stage, political leaders and activists joined in. "If a hasty election is arranged just to bring any party to power by destabilising the state, its consequences will be dire," he said.

So far, two accused have been arrested. However, the main suspects - Mohammad Farid Uddin, joint general secretary of Bhola Sramik Dal, and Mohammad Alauddin, a Jubo Dal activist - are still on the run.

Meanwhile, the survivor's family has alleged police inaction.

Rubel, the complainant and husband of the survivor, said, "The main

accused are influential. Police are not arresting them despite knowing their whereabouts. We believe they are hiding in Bhola, but due to political influence, no action is being taken."

Tajumuddin Police Station Officer-in-Charge Mohabbat Khan denied the allegation. "We are making every effort to arrest the prime accused. Multiple teams have been deployed and operations are ongoing

in remote areas," he said.

Contacted, Golam Nabi Alamgir, president of the Bhola district BNP, said, "We condemn the incident. No one is above the law. If anyone from our party is guilty, they must face justice."

He also accused a group of trying to "obstruct unity", saying, "We believe that the people know very well who are autocratic and who are democratic. Who established autocracy in this country, who supported autocracy directly or indirectly, and who were persecuted for persistently fighting for democracy."

"Thousands of people from a certain party have been forcibly disappeared, murdered, and millions of cases have been filed against them. The people know this, the people have seen this. They also know who has remained uncompromising in the fight for democracy. So, we do not believe that any

other political party can say something and that the people will accept it."

In response to a question about accountability within his own party, he said if any BNP leader is found guilty of a crime, they will face organisational action.

If the law takes its course, BNP will not stand in the way and would instead welcome the legal process, he added.
