

# 50 homes lost to river erosion in Jamalpur

Erosion by the Old Brahmaputra and Jingiraj rivers has devoured at least 50 houses in Jamalpur's Bakshiganj upazila, an official of the Water Development Board (WDB) said.

"The houses were washed away by the river within 20 to 25 days," said Bakshiganj UNO Masud Rana.

Md Nakibuzzaman Khan, executive engineer of Jamalpur's WDB, said, "New projects to protect the villages from the river water have been submitted, and once approved, the work to prevent erosion will begin quickly."

The houses are situated in Sheikhcharchar, Maicheni Char, Bhati Kolkhara, Khecharchar, Jagirpara and Aulpara under Merurchar union; Kushalnagar and Sajimara under Nilakshia union; and Airmari, Kutuberchar, Bangalpara, Khanpara, Char Airmari and Char Kamaler Battia areas under Sadhurpara union.

Zahidul Islam Monju, acting chairman of Merurchar union



parishad, said many more houses and even public institutions remain under threat as erosion has intensified in the area.

A farmer, Lutfar Rahman, said, "I've already moved my belongings twice, and now I'm relocating for the third time. My homestead is gone,

and I don't know where my family and I will stay."

UNO Masud Rana said the families affected by the river erosion will receive assistance.

"We are contacting the higher authorities to take preventive measures," he said.

## Dhaka seeks more trade ties

Trade between the two countries rose to US \$865 million in fiscal year 2024-25. Bangladesh's exports to Pakistan reached US \$78 million, up 20 percent from the previous year, while Pakistan's exports grew by 28 percent.

Since August last year, the two countries have started direct shipping, eased visa and trade regimes, and are preparing to launch direct flights.

At the meeting, Adilur Rahman Khan highlighted Bangladesh's industrial progress and growing needs.

Jam Kamal Khan expressed Pakistan's interest in collaborating through joint ventures and mutual investment. He called for a shared vision

to create an economic ecosystem that supports industrial growth and stressed the importance of value-added industries for revenue generation and socio-economic development.

He also praised Bangladesh's achievements in pharmaceuticals, textiles and information technology.

Jam Kamal Khan also met Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI) President Taskeen Ahmed to explore opportunities for trade and investment.

He appreciated DCCI's collaboration with Pakistani chambers of commerce and invited Bangladeshi businesses to participate in the 3rd International Food and

Agricultural Exhibition (FoodAg), to be held in Karachi on November 25-27, 2025.

The discussions covered potential cooperation in renewable energy, pharmaceuticals, automotive parts, FMCG, IT, and the fashion sector.

Taskeen Ahmed suggested enhancing bilateral trade through delegation exchanges, participation in exhibitions and knowledge sharing.

He also highlighted the importance of connecting SMEs from both countries.

The two sides also discussed tariff and non-tariff barriers and steps to improve logistics. The meeting ended with a commitment to create a supportive environment for bilateral trade.

## Ferry services suspended at Paturia as ramp snaps

Ferry services at Ghat-4 of Paturia in Manikganj have remained suspended since early yesterday after a pontoon and ramp were washed away by the Padma. Abdus Salam, deputy general manager of Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporation in the district, said operations came to a halt around 4:00am when the rope of the ramp snapped as Ro-Ro ferry attempted to dock.

The pontoon and ramp drifted away under strong currents before being pulled back near the ghat with the help of a tugboat.

According to the BIWTC official, efforts are underway to reinstall the structure, but ferry services will remain suspended until repairs are completed.

that the PP sent the judge a WhatsApp message two days ago, requesting bail for the accused in a rape case pending in her court.

On Wednesday, around 9:00am, Ruhul Amin allegedly sent court documents and a bundle of Tk 50,000 in a bag to the judge's residence through an unidentified person. The package was handed over to her house help, who then gave it to the judge.

The judge further alleged that the PP had also lobbied in favour of the accused in several other cases.

Calling the complaint a "conspiracy" against him, Ruhul Amin said, "The case in question was filed against BNP leaders and activists during the tenure of the previous fascist government. I merely informed the judge about the matter."

# Feni univ students block road for permanent campus

Students of Feni University blocked the Dhaka-Chittagong highway yesterday to press home their six-point demand, including permanent campus and shuttle bus services.

They took to the street at noon at Mohipal in Sadar upazila, halting vehicular movement on the highway for three hours from 11:00am.

The other demands include banning student politics on campus, changing the Board of Trustees, appointing a VC, and appointing an adequate number of teachers and



uncertainty."

Sajidul Islam, another student, said they have boycotted classes to force the authorities to fulfil their demands.

Mentionable, on Wednesday, Vice-Chancellor Prof M Jamal Uddin Ahmed resigned amid growing unrest.

Md Ariful Islam Siddique, additional superintendent of Feni (Sadar circle), said police dispersed the students from the highway with a promise to sit with the deputy commissioner over their demands.
