Litton also surpassed retired Mahmudullah Riyad to become the second-highest run getter in T20s for Bangladesh. He started his 11th T20I game with 2,437 career runs beside his name, needing eight more to overtake Riyad (2,444 runs in 141 matches). The first spot is held by all-rounder Shakib Al Hasan, who has scored 2551 runs in 129 T20Is.

Having elected to field first, bowlers ensured that Bangladesh had a modest total to chase, with pacers Taskin Ahmed and Tanzim

Hasan Sakib scalping two wickets each. Leg-spinner Rishad Hossain got two wickets for 31 runs in his four overs, becoming the sixth Bangladeshi bowler to get to 50 T20I wickets.

Rishad got both his scalps in the final two deliveries of his spell, removing Hong Kong's top scorer of the game, Nizakat Khan (42 off 40) and Kinchit Shah (0 off 1). This also meant Rishad would be on a hat-trick the next time he comes on to bowl for Bangladesh.

Bangladesh will next play Sri Lanka tomorrow at the same venue.

## Rift persists over implementation

Commission Vice-President Prof Ali Riaz said there was consensus on swiftly implementing reforms that could be carried out by ordinances or administrative orders of the interim government.

The charter, he said, reflected the views of all stakeholders, and parties had been asked to submit two names by tomorrow to sign it.

"The question now is whether consensus can be reached or a pathway established on the constitutional matters. We remain hopeful that progress is possible," he added.

Experts had recommended ordinance, executive order, referendum and constitutional order.

The BNP had proposed that all parties commit to the charter in their election manifestos, with the winner responsible for its implementation, including constitutional reforms, within two years of taking office.

The Jamaat e-Islami had called for a "Provisional Constitutional Order," effective from August 5, 2024, placing the charter above all existing laws.

The National Citizen Party and AB Party had demanded a constituent assembly, while Islami Andolan Bangladesh suggested a presidential proclamation.

G a n o s a m h a t i Andolan had called for a "Constitutional Reform Council", implementation of constitutional matters within six months of the next government taking office, and full charter implementation within a year.

R a s i r o s h o n g s k a r Andolan had sought election to a "Constitution Reform Convention/Assembly" along with parliamentary polls.

Several parties, including AB Party, Khelafat Majlish, Zaker Party and Gono Odhikar Parishad, support a referendum, while the Samajtantrik Dal (Marxist) backed one only if consensus emerged.

The Communist Party of Bangladesh, Bangladesher Samajtantrik Dal and GonoForum insisted that constitutional changes should be left to the next parliament.

Yesterday, BNP Standing Committee member Salahuddin Ahmed dismissed other options as "generally unacceptable", stressing that constitutional continuity must be preserved.

A constituent assembly, he argued, is only justified for drafting a new constitution or altering its basic structure. He also noted that a Provisional Constitutional Order, as in 1972, was relevant only when no constitution existed, while proclamations during Ziaur Rahman's tenure merely suspended the constitution before being legitimised by parliament.

Jamaat Assistant Secretary General Hamidur Rahman Azad countered

constitutional amendments will be, he said at the event organised by civil society platform Nagorik Coalition.

"However, we cannot allow a precedent to be set that will be challenged in the relevant court, and remain questionable and problematic for ratification in parliament."

The ongoing reform, election, and trial have no "clear interdependency," Salahuddin said, while stressing that the trial should not be "conditional" on any specific timeframe but must be conducted by an independent judiciary.

Political parties have to compromise over key reform issues to reach a consensus, said Ahsanul Mahboob Zubair, assistant secretary general of Jamaat e-Islami, adding that the EC must do its duty with "hundred percent neutrality" to ensure a credible election.

The chief adviser has reiterated his commitment that the election will take place in the first half of February next year, said his Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam.

Besides, the chief adviser further warned that any derailment could have devastating consequences for the country, he said.

Key stakeholders in the government have been

holding regular meetings to ensure a free, fair and credible election.

The recently held Dhaka University Central Students' Union polls was a "big test" for the students who passed it successfully with no major law and order situation and high turnout, Alam added.

The EC must launch its campaign for poll environment this month by forming an "observation coordination committee", said Zonayed Saki, chief coordinator of Ganosamhati Andolan.

It will not be possible to hold the election properly by taking the present law and order situation lightly, said Jasmine Tuli, an expert on elections.

Referring to the planned 42,000-odd polling centres and nearly 250,000 polling booths for the upcoming polls, she said it will not be possible for the Election Commission alone to monitor all the establishments.

She suggested creating teams consisting of various stakeholders including political party members, police and officials from the administration and the EC for election monitoring.

The EC and the administration must ensure a level playing field for all political parties during the election, she added.

There are concerns over the polls being peaceful given that political parties remain divided, especially over the implementation of the proposed July National Charter, said Dilip Kumar Sarkar, chief coordinator of Shushashoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan).

With the election approaching, voters should create pressure on the candidates for a clear mandate about eradicating menace like corruption and unemployment, said Justice MA Matin, acting president of Shujan.

A fair and safe election is an aspiration of every citizen of the country, said Photographer and Drik founder Shahidul Alam, while urging political parties to demonstrate tolerance for a successful election.

The EC must tackle illicit financing during the polls and take preventive measures to stop rumours on social media, said Hasnat Abdullah, chief organiser for the Southern region of the National Citizen Party.

BNP Organising Secretary Shama Obaed, Islami Andolan Bangladesh Joint Secretary General Sheikh Fazle Bari Masud, Gono Odhikar Parishad General Secretary Rashed Khan and Nagorik Coalition Co-Convenor AKM Fahim Mashroor spoke among others at the discussion.

"Therefore, keeping the election in mind, we must finalise the basic reforms. At the same time, we must remember that we have no alternative but to hold elections in the first half of February," he added.

Yunus said reform is one of the three main mandates of the incumbent interim government. Thus, the issue of the July Charter must be considered with the same level of importance as elections and justice, he continued.

The two-hour-long meeting discussed the proposals put forward by the Consensus Commission regarding the implementation of the July Charter, as well as the proposals from political parties in this regard.

Consensus Commission

members told the meeting that the commission would soon submit its report to the interim government, the press release read.

The National Consensus Commission will meet again with the political parties next Sunday to take this issue forward.

Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Prof Ali Riaz, Commission members Justice Md Emdadul Haque, Dr Iftekharuzzaman, Badiul Alam Majumder, Md Ayub Mia and Special Assistant to the Chief Advisor Monir Haider were present at the meeting.

Interim government advisers Muhammad Fawzul Kabir Khan, Asif Nazrul, Syeda Rizwana Hasan and National Security Adviser Khalilur Rahman were also present.

Proposals agreed upon in the first two rounds of talks, some can be implemented through government orders or existing laws. But a significant portion requires constitutional amendments.

At the outset of yesterday's talks, the commission presented parties with a document setting out possible implementation methods, based on consultations with parties and experts.

Earlier, political parties had suggested options such as a referendum on all or parts of the charter, a Special Constitutional Order by the president, a constituent assembly, enactment through the next parliament, designating parliament as a constitutional reform assembly, and seeking the Supreme Court's opinion under article 106 of the
