Brahmaputra's erosion leaves hundreds homeless

The erosion of the Brahmaputra River has intensified recently in Char Pakshimari union under Sherpur Sadar upazila, leaving several hundred people homeless.

The erosion has become particularly severe in Bagolgarh, Kulurchar, Bepaipara, Batpara, and Dhakpara areas. In Bagolgarh village alone, around 30 families have been rendered homeless overnight.

Many victims have taken shelter in relatives' or neighbours' homes, while others are struggling to rebuild their shelters elsewhere, said Pori Begum, a member of the union parishad.

Khokhi Begum, 60, of Bagolgarh village, said she now lives in a neighbour's house after losing her homestead in the recent spate of erosion. "The Brahmaputra devoured

my home right before my eyes."

Monto Mia, 50, a share-cropper from the village, said he has lost everything and has been forced to relocate with his two children.

Hundreds of families in the area are now living in fear of further erosion.



Victims said they have appealed to the deputy commissioner of Sherpur for support and to the authorities of the Water Development Board for immediate measures to strengthen riverbank protection.

BWDB officials have started

dumping geo-bags along a 130-metre stretch of the riverbank in the erosion-hit areas. Geo-tubes will also be deployed to further enhance protection against erosion, said Akhinnuzaman, executive engineer of BWDB in Sherpur.

Due to river dredging followed by recent flash floods, the erosion has taken a serious turn in different areas of Sherpur, including Narayankhola, Kamarerchar, and Char Pakshimari, he added.

"We have also informed the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority about the erosion and sought their financial assistance to contain it. They have agreed to our proposal and official work has begun," the official confirmed.

"We have a plan for a project to build a permanent embankment along the riverbank in the affected areas."

Two brothers electrocuted in Lalmonirhat

Two brothers died from electrocution in Kaliganj upazila of Lalmonirhat yesterday afternoon.

The deceased were Nur Islam, 54, and Delwar Hossain, 42, of Bakalitari village of Chowbala union.

Their paternal uncle Sirajul Islam and nephew Yasin Ali were injured in the incident.

According to locals, Nur was electrocuted while connecting an irrigation pump near their home around 12:00pm. Delwar rushed to save him but got electrocuted.

Yasin and Sirajul Islam also suffered electric shock while trying to rescue them.

Villagers later rescued all four and rushed them to Aditmari Upazila Health Complex. Nur and Delwar were brought dead while the two others were being treated, said Omor Faruk, deputy assistant medical officer of the health complex.

Passenger dies after falling from moving train in Jamalpur

A passenger died after falling from a moving train in Melandah upazila of Jamalpur yesterday.

The deceased is Rahim Uddin Molla, 55, of Phulchhari upazila in Gaibandha.

The incident happened in the outer area of Melandah Railway Station around 11:30am, said Robiul Islam, officer-in-charge of Jamalpur Railway Police Station.

The OC said Rahim was travelling to Jamalpur on a commuter train from Dhaka. He fell asleep while sitting near the train door, accidentally fell off, and died on the spot.

His cousin Abdul Mannan identified the body.

The OC also said police recovered the body and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy. An unnatural death case was filed in this connection.

"We thought it was just a regular fever and only took him to the doctor when his belly became swollen," said his mother, Chadni Akter.

Like these patients, many others in critical condition are being admitted to general wards at Mitford Hospital, most of them arriving late and only getting tested three or more days after fever began.

According to findings of the Directorate General of Health Services released on September 22, 81 percent of dengue patients who died this year were admitted to hospitals only after suffering from fever for three or more days.

The report also shows that 74 percent of patients died within 48 hours of admission, while 50 percent succumbed to Dengue Shock Syndrome. Around 43 percent of the deceased had comorbidities.

"If a dengue patient arrives at the hospital in the final stage, even if measures are taken, they are usually not effective," said Prof Md Abu Jafor, director general of DGHS.

Health officials stressed that early testing and timely hospitalisation are crucial.

Although DGHS has instructed hospitals to designate separate wards for dengue patients, Mitford authorities said they are prioritising only severe cases.

Dr Md Mafizur Rahman, assistant director (finance and store) at Mitford Hospital, told The Daily Star on Thursday, "We have separate beds in each ward for dengue patients and adequate logistics and doctors. On Thursday, the

number of dengue patients stood at 53. If the number rises significantly, we have separate arrangements ready."

Dr HM Nazmul Ahsan, associate professor at Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College Hospital, recommended early admission for elderly patients, those with comorbidities, and expecting women to reduce risks.

He also warned about cross-infection from different dengue serotypes, which can cause severe complications if treatment is delayed.
