

Trapped in knee-deep water

Waterlogging plagues Sarankhola residents

Due to the lack of a proper drainage system, large parts of Rayenda union in Bagerhat's Sarankhola upazila has remained waterlogged for more than four months.

As a result, around 200 to 250 families – including those living near RKDS Girls' School, the old post office area, and Rayenda Bazar Dakhil Madrasa – continue to suffer while trapped in knee-deep water.

Setara Begum, 50, a resident of Kadamtala area, said, “We use this water for all our washing because we have no other option.”

Another resident, Salam Hawladar echoed her.

Sarankhola Upazila Health Officer Priyo Gopal Biswas said, “Bathing or washing in dirty water can cause various skin diseases and itching, and may also increase the risk of urinary infections among women. Drinking polluted water can lead to diarrhoea, dysentery, typhoid, and hepatitis B. About 20 percent of the patients coming to our hospital are suffering from skin-related ailments.”

Sarankhola UNO Sudipto Kumar Sinha said they have tried several times to dig channels and install pipes to drain the water, but the work was halted after some landowners refused to cede their land. He said discussions are ongoing with local leaders to find a solution.

The government has introduced a set of guidelines to protect the environment and biodiversity of Saint Martin's Island, Bangladesh's only coral island.

The environment ministry issued a notification yesterday, outlining 12 specific conditions for visiting the island, including limitations on tourist numbers, travel schedules, and bans on single-use plastics and disruptive activities.

The notification states that the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority cannot permit vessels to operate to Saint Martin's without prior approval from the ministry.

Tourists must purchase tickets through the Bangladesh Tourism Board's official web portal, each carrying a travel

pass and a QR code. Tickets without QR codes will be considered invalid.

To reduce ecological pressure, the number of daily visitors is capped at 2,000. Travel and stay rules vary by season.

Under the new guidelines, tourist access to Saint Martin's Island will be strictly seasonal: only day trips will be allowed in November, with no overnight stays permitted; overnight stays will be allowed in December and January; and the island will be completely closed to tourism in February.

The government has also banned lighting, loud noise, and barbecue parties on beaches at night, as well as the use of motorcycles, sea bikes, or any motorized vehicles.

Additionally, tourists are prohibited from carrying

polythene and are discouraged from bringing single-use plastics such as packets of chips, plastic straws, and mini toiletry packs.

Entry into Keya forests, collection or trade of Keya fruits, and harming marine life – such as turtles, birds, corals, crabs, starfish, and seaweed – are strictly prohibited.

To reduce plastic pollution, tourists are discouraged from bringing chip packets, plastic spoons or straws, miniature soap or shampoo packs, and 500ml or 1,000ml plastic water bottles to Saint Martin's Island.

Instead, they are encouraged to carry reusable water flasks.

A coordination meeting on eco-friendly tourism was held at the ministry on Tuesday, chaired by Syeda Rizwana Hasan, adviser to the ministry.

An amendment proposal was sent to the cabinet in October 2023 and later to the interim government's advisory council in November 2024, but it was not approved. Instead, a committee led by Finance Adviser Salehuddin Ahmed was formed to review it again.

Citing WHO data, Farzana Rahman Munmun, joint general secretary of Platform Doctors Foundation, said Bangladesh records around 1.61 lakh tobacco-related deaths every year, with 21 percent caused by passive

smoking.

Mostafizur Rahman, lead policy adviser at Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids, said the proposed amendment has been pending for nearly a year. “Had it been approved, many lives could have been saved. Who will take responsibility for this delay?” he asked.

Dhaka Divisional Commissioner Sharf Uddin Ahmed Choudhury said the law must be updated to address emerging issues like e-cigarettes, which were not a concern in 2013.

Sheikh Momena Moni,

programme director of the National Tobacco Control Cell, said resistance to the amendment likely stems from the proposed ban on selling loose or unpackaged tobacco products.

Tobacco companies target young people who buy loose cigarettes due to financial constraints, she said, adding, “The proposed amendment will put an end to that.”

According to a 2019 study by the Bangladesh Cancer Society, tobacco use caused economic losses of Tk 30,560 crore in 2017–18, while the government earned Tk 22,810 crore in revenue from the sector that year.

Prof Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder, adviser to the Primary and Mass Education Ministry, said tobacco companies employ various tactics to advance their interests. They exploit loopholes in the law and influence policymakers

and civil society through activities like tree plantation drives, he added.

He said tobacco products should be classified as addictive substances.

Prof Khondker Abdul Awal Rizvi, president of the Heart Foundation, said tobacco is a major cause of non-communicable diseases, including heart disease, stroke, and chronic respiratory illness.

“We cannot manage this burden with treatment alone. Prevention through strict tobacco control must be the priority,” he said.

Man killed in 'gunfight' between BGB, smugglers

A man was shot dead, allegedly during an attack and counterattack between a group of smugglers and the Border Guard Bangladesh members in Sylhet's Jaintiapur upazila yesterday.

The deceased is Almas Uddin, 30, of Nayakhel Purbo village under Charikata union. The incident took place around 10:00am, near the Balidara Kandirmukh Mosque.

Abul Bashar Md Badruzzaman, officer-in-charge of Jaintiapur Police Station, said, “Almas was shot dead during a gunfight between BGB and smugglers. However, whose bullet hit him is yet to be confirmed.”

Lt Col Zubayer Anwar, commanding officer of BGB Zakiganj Battalion, in a press note, said a group of smugglers carrying betel nuts from India was chased by a patrol team near the Suraihat Border Outpost.

The smugglers at one point attacked the BGB unit, and in self defence, the BGB personnel opened 4-5 rounds of fire. A BGB member was injured in the attack and is undergoing treatment. Despite repeated attempts, the commanding officer could not be reached for comments.

NATIONAL POLLS CEC urges UNOs to resist pressure, act by law

Chief Election Commissioner AMM Nasir Uddin yesterday urged the UNOs to resist all forms of pressure or influence while performing election duties and to act strictly in line with the law.

He was speaking at a training programme on election management in Agargaon, Dhaka.

Nasir Uddin cautioned that executive magistrates often reach polling centres after incidents occur. “By the time they arrive, scuffles may have ended, centres seized, or ballot boxes taken. You must ensure that does not happen,” he said.

He also called for strong cooperation with law enforcement agencies and election officials.



Dengue death toll rises to 255

With two more dengue-related deaths reported yesterday, this year's death toll has risen to 255, painting an alarming picture of the ongoing outbreak.

According to the Directorate General of Health Services, 762 new dengue cases were recorded, bringing the total number of infections this year to 62,367.

Currently, 2,670 patients are receiving treatment at hospitals across the country, including 1,709 outside Dhaka.

HM Nazmul Ahsan, associate professor at Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College Hospital, told The Daily Star that most patients arrive with low blood pressure and symptoms of shock, particularly those who deteriorate after their fever subsides.
