

Man dies after falling down staircase at CMCH

A man died after falling down a staircase in the main building of Chittagong Medical College Hospital on Sunday night.

The deceased is Jahangir Alam, 65, of Hathazari upazila in Chattogram, said police.

The incident occurred around 10:00pm in front of the hospital's Gynaecology Ward.

CMCH sources said, Jahangir Alam was visiting a relative undergoing treatment in the ward on the fifth floor of the hospital. He suddenly fell while descending the stairs from that floor and sustained severe injuries.

"He was declared dead at the emergency department," said Alaudin Talukdar, in-charge of CMCH Police Camp.

DEMAND FOR PRO-VC'S RESIGNATION CU students lock admin building

Students of Chittagong University yesterday padlocked the university's administrative building, demanding resignation of Pro-Vice Chancellor (Academic) Prof Shamim Uddin Khan over his remarks about the martyred intellectuals of 1971.

During the protest, two pro-VCs were confined to the building. Demonstrators under banner of Sarbodhilo Chhatro Oikko, comprising leaders and activists of Jatiyatobadi Chhatro Dal and the Democratic Student Council, said they would not remove the locks until their demand is met.

The gates were padlocked around 12:30pm and were still locked till filing of this report in the evening. A standoff ensued, with Chhatro Dal activists taking positions in front of the main gate, while Chhatro Shibir activists occupying both sides of the building. Both groups were chanting slogans, while members of CU's security department stood between the two sides to prevent escalation.

CU JCD general secretary Abdullah Al



Noman termed it a moral obligation to protest the pro-VC's disrespectful remarks.

"The pro-VC of a public university can't make such remarks. He must resign," he said.

CU VC Prof Muhammad Yeahia Akhter said he was attending a programme at the time and declined to comment.

The controversy arose from a discussion meeting at the CU VC's conference room on Sunday, marking the 54th Martyred Intellectuals' Day, where Prof Shamim said he finds it "utterly absurd that Pakistani fighters would kill Bangladeshi intellectuals".

Meanwhile, the CU's History department issued a statement, saying it remains uncompromising on the spirit of the Liberation War, truth, and ethical historiography.

It also said the pro-VC had distorted the history with his "brazen and deeply offensive" remark in an attempt to justify the Pakistani occupation forces.

Similarly, CU's English department also expressed deep concern and strong condemnation, calling the pro-VC's remarks irresponsible, unethical, and wholly condemnable.

Man killed over land dispute in Mirsarai

A man was killed allegedly by his nephew over a land dispute in Mirsarai upazila of Chattogram yesterday.

The deceased, Abul Kalam, 55, died as his nephew Helal Uddin hit him with a brick.

The incident occurred in the morning in Uttar Sonapahar area of Jorargonj union, according to police.

There was a longstanding land dispute between Abul Kalam and Helal Uddin, said police and local sources.

Yesterday morning, they got into an altercation, at one stage of which Helal struck Kalam with a brick, leaving him severely injured.

He was immediately taken to the upazila health complex, before being shifted to Chattogram Medical College Hospital, where the on-duty doctor pronounced him dead.

Helal has been on the run since the incident. Police said efforts are on to nab him, said Kazi Nazmul Haque, officer-in-charge of Jorargonj Police Station.

4,000-litre illegal liquor destroyed

Around 4,000 litres of illegal homemade liquor were intercepted and destroyed by locals in Chattogram's Satkania upazila on Sunday night.

The liquor was packaged in polythene bags of one litre volume and then loaded into sacks in a mini-truck, concealed under straw.

Around 10:00pm, locals intercepted the mini-truck in the Kerani Hat area of the upazila, removed the sacks of liquor and set those on fire, said police.

"Police went to the spot and brought the truck to the station. Those transporting the liquor fled the scene. The truck was coming from Bandarban, but its destination remains unknown. We are investigating the matter," said OC Manzurul Haque of Satkania Police Station.



Raktakarabi holds musical event in Ctg

The event concluded with all the artistes singing the title song "O Alor Pothojatri".



Cable company fined Tk 12 lakh

A mobile court of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-7) yesterday fined Tk 12 lakh to One Plus cable company in Sadarghat area of Chattogram city for manufacturing substandard electric cables without a BSTI license.

Rab-7's Executive Magistrate Abu Hasan and Commanding Officer Lt Col Hafizur Rahman led the drive from 11:00am to 2:00pm.

"The inspection revealed that the company had been manufacturing cables below fire safety standards and without a BSTI license. The mobile court seized a huge amount of substandard cables and fined the company Tk 12 lakh," said the executive magistrate.
