

TRUMP'S GAZA PLAN Pak military chief Munir in spotlight

Pakistan's most powerful military chief in decades faces the toughest test of his newly amassed powers as Washington pushes Islamabad to contribute troops to the Gaza stabilisation force, a move analysts say could spark domestic backlash.

Field Marshal Asim Munir is expected to fly to Washington to meet President Donald Trump in the coming weeks for a third meeting in six months that will likely focus on the Gaza force, two sources told Reuters, one of them a key player in the general's economic diplomacy.

Many countries are wary of the mission to demilitarise Gaza's Hamas, which could drag them into the conflict and enrage their pro-Palestinian and anti-Israeli populations. But Munir has built a close relationship with the mercurial Trump to repair years of mistrust between Washington and Islamabad. In June, he was rewarded with a White House lunch - the first time a US president hosted Pakistan's army chief alone, without civilian officials.

Romanian journos back outlet behind graft protests

Dozens of Romanian journalists and several NGOs signed an open letter yesterday backing an under pressure media outlet whose investigation sparked nationwide anti-corruption protests.

The Recorder outlet's two-hour documentary into corruption in the court system touched a nerve in the eastern European country, which ranks as one of the most graft-ridden in the EU, according to Transparency International's corruption perception index.

Thousands have taken to the streets in rolling protests over the past week, but senior judicial officials have hit back and accused the outlet of being part of a “campaign to destabilise the judiciary”.

The open letter published yesterday condemned “repeated and aggressive attacks” on the work done by Recorder, especially coming from within the judiciary.

VENEZUELA OIL TANKERS Trump orders ‘blockade’ of sanctioned vessels

US President Donald Trump ordered on Tuesday a “blockade” of all sanctioned oil tankers entering and leaving Venezuela, in Washington's latest move to increase pressure on Nicolas Maduro's government, targeting its main source of income.

It is unclear how Trump will impose the move against the sanctioned vessels, and whether he will turn to the Coast Guard to interdict vessels like he did last week. The administration has moved thousands of troops and nearly a dozen warships - including an aircraft carrier - to the region.

The US aviation regulator issued a renewed warning on Tuesday to civilian aircraft operating in Venezuelan airspace, citing the dangers of military activity, reports AFP.

“For the theft of our Assets, and many other reasons, including Terrorism, Drug Smuggling, and Human Trafficking, the Venezuelan Regime has been designated a FOREIGN TERRORIST ORGANIZATION,” Trump wrote

on Truth Social. “Therefore, today, I am ordering A TOTAL AND COMPLETE BLOCKADE OF ALL SANCTIONED OIL TANKERS going into, and out of, Venezuela.”

In a statement, Venezuela's government said it rejected Trump's “grotesque threat.”

Trump has also said that US land strikes on the South American country will soon start. Maduro has alleged that the US military build-up is aimed at overthrowing him and gaining control of the OPEC nation's oil resources, which are the world's largest crude reserves, reports Reuters.

Oil prices rose more than one percent in Asian trade yesterday. US crude futures climbed over one percent to \$55.96 a barrel in Asian trading after Trump's announcement. Oil prices settled at \$55.27 a barrel on Tuesday, the lowest close since February 2021.

American presidents have broad discretion to deploy US forces abroad, but Trump's asserted blockade marks a new test of presidential authority, said international law scholar Elena Chachko of UC Berkeley Law School.

BONDI SHOOTING Alleged killer charged with 15 murders

A man who allegedly opened fire on a Jewish Hanukkah celebration on Sydney's famed Bondi Beach has been charged with 59 offences, including murder and terrorism, police said yesterday.

The alleged father-and-son perpetrators opened fire on the celebration at Sydney's famed Bondi Beach on Sunday, killing 15 in an attack that shook the nation and intensified fears of rising antisemitism and violent extremism.

Funerals of the Jewish victims of the attack began yesterday, amid anger over how the gunmen - one of whom was briefly investigated



for links to extremists - were allowed access to powerful firearms.

Sajid Akram, 50, was shot dead by police at the scene, while his 24-year-old son Naveed Akram emerged from a coma on Tuesday afternoon after also being shot by police.

Police said yesterday that a man had been charged with 59 offences, including 15 counts of murder, 40 counts of wounding with attempt to murder, as well as a terror offence and other charges.

Meanwhile, the Philippines said yesterday there was no evidence that the country was being used for terrorist training, after it was revealed the men behind shooting had spent November on a southern island.
