

The bodies will be taken to the Central Mosque at Dhaka Cantonment today for a prayer service. They will then be flown by helicopter to the soldiers' respective hometowns for burial with full military honours.

Nine other Bangladeshi peacekeepers were injured in the same attack. Eight of them are receiving treatment at the Aga Khan University Hospital, a Level-3 facility, in Nairobi, Kenya, and are in stable condition, according to ISPR.

Earlier, the Bangladesh Army said a separatist armed group carried out the drone attack on the Kadugli Logistics Base under the UN peacekeeping mission in the Abyei area on December 13, killing six peacekeepers and injuring nine others.

In recognition of his lifelong dedication, Abed was posthumously awarded the Independence Award 2025, Bangladesh's highest civilian honour.

Internationally, he was recognised as one of Ashoka's "Global Greats" and served as a founding member of its Global Academy for Social Entrepreneurship. The British Crown awarded him the Most Distinguished

Order of Saint Michael and Saint George in 2009. He was also named among the United Nations' "Eminent Persons" in 2010 and featured in Forbes Magazine's list of the world's top 50 leaders in 2014 and 2017.

Abed also received numerous honorary degrees, including Doctor of Laws from Princeton University (2014), Doctor of Letters from the University of Oxford (2009), Doctor of Laws from Columbia University (2008), and Doctorate of Humane Letters from Yale University (2007).

Prothom Alo, and Chhayanaut. These are not random acts. They represent a deliberate threat to freedom of expression and democratic rights," said Amit Ranjan Dey.

Calling the destruction of Udichi's archives a cultural catastrophe, Dey said decades of documentation – songs, scripts, photographs, and records of resistance – had been destroyed overnight.

"This is not just an attack on a building. It is an attempt to erase memory," he said.

Udichi leaders warned that continued inaction would embolden extremist forces further.

They also argued that the state's failure to ensure the safety of cultural and media institutions risks undermining its own democratic foundations.

They demanded immediate identification, arrest, and prosecution of those responsible for the attack, and pledged to remain on the streets until accountability is ensured.

Udichi assistant general secretary Pradip Ghosh and CPB Dhaka north president Hasan Hafizur Rahman Sohel also spoke among others.


