Since August 5, 2024, Sufi shrines across the country have increasingly come under mob attacks. According to a January study by Maqam: Center for Sufi Heritage, at least 97 shrines were attacked between August 5, 2024, and December 31, 2025, leaving at least three people dead and 468 injured.
