

Karnaphuli Tunnel Teesta plan a national

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electricity supply, lighting, ventilation, fire safety systems, CCTV, and traffic management inside the tunnel, Rabiul added.

He also said that steps were underway to make the tunnel profitable.

The minister said parts of the Dhaka Elevated Expressway project were facing delays due to financial difficulties within the investing institution.

“Due to complications related to the transfer of shares among the shareholders of the project’s investment institutions, the loan instalments from the China Exim Bank and Industrial & Commercial Bank of China have been suspended,” he said.

“If the financial difficulties of the investing institution are resolved, the project will be fully operational by December 2028,” he added.

In reply to a query from Nazmun Nahar MP, the minister said the government plans to launch the country’s first Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) along a 20.5 km corridor from Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport to Gazipur’s Shibbari to ease the capital’s traffic congestion.

Responding to lawmaker Mohammad Nurul Islam’s query, Rabiul said GPS devices will be installed in all public transport vehicles to curb reckless driving and disorder and ensure safety.

In reply to a query by Nipun Roy Chowdhury MP, Rabiul, also the railways minister, said a pilot project had been undertaken to install automatic barriers at three separate level crossings in Dhaka with Buet’s assistance.

He said all necessary

government believes it is not limited to border protection alone. It also covers sovereignty, public safety, economic stability, food and energy security, cybersecurity, and strategic capacity.

The government has begun building a defence system, enhancing defence industry capabilities, and modernising defence management, he said.

Labelling film, drama, music, and sports as part of the “creative economy”, Tarique said initiatives had been taken to bring these sectors into the mainstream of the national economy.

Turning to energy, the prime minister said the government inherited a sector plagued by limitless corruption, waste of public funds due to flawed planning, and contracts that sidelined domestic companies such as BAPEX in favour of foreign firms.

measures were being taken to restore discipline in the energy sector, including diversifying energy sources, expanding domestic gas exploration, promoting renewable energy, and improving energy efficiency.

Tarique also said the treasury and opposition benches could work together in parliament on constitutional amendments, with the July charter serving as the guiding framework.

The prime minister said Bangladesh could also advance reforms beyond parliament by building public support for issues of national importance and pursuing reform-oriented programmes.

Agreeing with Opposition Leader Shafiqur Rahman, Tarique acknowledged that differences might exist between the treasury and opposition benches.

“But we shall remain united on reviving the economy to ease people’s suffering, restoring discipline and rebuilding trust in the financial sector, creating opportunities for farmers, workers, youth and expatriate entrepreneurs, and strengthening democratic institutions,” he said.

“Let our pledge today be that in this Bangladesh, fascism or autocracy shall never again take root, and no one shall ever turn this country into a client state,” he added.

The prime minister reassured citizens that both his government and parliament belong to the people.

His remarks came as Jamaat had yet to formally respond to the ruling party’s request for the opposition to nominate members to a proposed parliamentary committee on constitutional amendments.

On June 16, Opposition Leader and Jamaat Ameer Shafiqur Rahman told a press conference that the opposition would not nominate representatives to the government’s proposed amendment committee, stressing that it favoured constitutional reform rather than mere amendment.

Tk 20 crore

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Responding to questions from opposition MPs, he said the funds will be distributed through district councils, adding that city corporation areas would be covered later.

Speaker Hafiz Uddin Ahmed then said despite serving in parliament for 40 years, including as an opposition MP, he had never received such an allocation.

“I was arrested and jailed five times. That is all I got, nothing more,” he said.

The speaker also praised opposition leader Shafiqur Rahman for raising a range of national issues during the budget discussion.

He expressed hope that Prime Minister Tarique Rahman and Finance Minister Amir Khosru Mahmud Chowdhury would give “due consideration” to the opposition leader’s remarks.

Power cuts grip Ctg amid heat

Chattogram’s daily power demand usually fluctuates between 1,500 MW and 1,600 MW. On Sunday at 7:00pm, peak demand rose to 1,621.40 MW, but the city received 1,528.90 MW from the grid.

“We faced a deficit of 92.50 MW at that hour, leaving us with no option but to cut power,” Hossain said.

Documents obtained by The Daily Star, however, show that the Chattogram region generates far more electricity than it consumes.

On Sunday evening, 17 of the region’s 28 power plants were operational, jointly supplying 2,987.40 MW to the national grid during peak hours and 2,405.87 MW during morning off-peak hours.

The documents show that 11 power plants in the region were idle on Sunday. Among them, two of the five units at the Kaptai Hydroelectric Power Plant were shut due to low water levels in Kaptai Lake, while both units of the Raozan Thermal Power Plant were out of commission due to a severe fuel shortage, PDB sources said.

Contacted, Kamal

Uddin, chief engineer (distribution) of PDB, Chattogram, said, “The electricity generated by local power plants goes directly into the national grid, from which a part of it is allocated back to us.”

“If the national grid’s transmission to Chattogram falls short of local demand, we have to enforce load shedding,” he added.

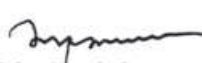

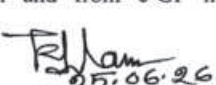

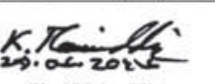
